The only space i-Plow occupies in your county's network is an icon on your desktop. Your implementation will occupy space on one of our servers in the i-Plow network.

Options

The Options menu on the Core Window provides most of the controls you need to optimize your display and prepare your workstation as you need for i-Plow. Features that impact the look of your display include:

There are two logons to i-Plow. One to access your implementation and the other to access your software. You can turn that into a single logon with this feature.

[My 3D and My bold display text](#)

Graphic options to improve readability of the display.

[My color/font scheme](#)

Set your own color combinations.

[My screen optimization](#)

Don't like squinting? Optimize the display to utilize the full window.

[My DD Event Display](#)

Want to reduce jumping back and forth between the Plan and Due Diligence, Assessments, and Payments Windows? Add assessments and payments to the [DD Event Log](#).

[My Paths](#)

Use this feature to tell i-Plow where you intend to place images of documents and pictures of defendants so that they may be imported into Government Collections & Compliance. *You* define the location

[Printer Selection](#)

You can view your available printers and select one for use with [My printer selection](#).

[My Shortcuts](#)

You can reduce the amount of clicking on menus that you have to do by defining your own keyboard shortcuts, taking advantage of your keyboard's function keys.
